Where is Central African Republic launching a new solar park? BANGUI, November 17, - Today, the Central African Republic is launching a new 25-megawatt solar park with battery storage in Danzi village, located around 18 kilometers from Bangui. The park will supply electricity to 250,000 persons in the capital, almost doubling the country's electricity generation capacity. Will Central African Republic have electricity by ?
