



Greece has new energy storage companies

An investment 'fever' is gripping the new energy storage sector as the ministerial decision was published yesterday (March 14,), setting the rules for installations with a total capacity of 4.7 GW in our country. So far, three auctions have supported 900 MW projects with The nation is giving energy storage solutions top priority in order to meet its electricity consumption target of 61% renewable energy.
