Sweden formally reported its draft Integrated Energy and Climate Plan on 17 January 2019. The Commission assessed the draft plans of all Member States and, on 18 June, issued recommendations for each of the plans along with a general assessment of whether they are ambitious enough to meet the common EU goals. When will Sweden's national energy & climate plan be updated? The Governance Regulation (Article 14) requires the plans to be updated by 30 June and every ten years thereafter.
