What is the UK funding for solar geoengineering? The UK government has announced new funding for scientists to conduct outdoor experiments on solar geoengineering. £56.8m will be awarded to researchers through the Advanced Research and Invention Agency (ARIA), with the aim of filling knowledge-gaps on the mechanisms and effects of various methods to cool the Earth. Should risky solar geoengineering projects be halted?
